This cemetery is near the rear edge of what was known as Hildebron Ridge, where the Hilderbrand homestead was located. The spring and barn foundation near the front of the land can still be seen, 2008. It appears the one tombstone, with two brothers possibly were taken to the rear of the property during a logging project on or near the family graveyard. The stones are in the pattern of a tablet, made of thin marble, the footstone with both initials were found nearby. The tombstone was leaning up against a rotten tree, and no apparent cemetery nearby. Signs of other native stone, sandstone were nearby, laying on the ground, no bases found, This area is hilly, ridges and dense growth, except in the winter or early spring.
