Driving Directions - From US State Route 22
West of Steubenville take State Route 43
(Carrollton) Exit. Turn right (north) on State
Route 43. Travel 7.5 miles through Richmond
and turn left (south) onto Township Road 220 for
approximately 0.7 miles. The cemetery is on the
left side of the road. There is a white sign in front
of the cemetery that can be seen from the road.
The land is owned by the Swearingen Family.
There is a newly built home next door near the
cemetery property. You may get permission from
owners to park in their driveway to access the
cemetery. Or you can park on the rural road and
walk back to the cemetery. The above was taken
